- 1-2 years experience (Must be able to play/lead through guitar/keys, both would be a plus)
- Commitment to personal spiritual growth and healthy lifestyle
- Model standards and expectations of leaders within Connection Church including:
 1. Member of Connection Church and attending regularly
 2. Tithing 10%
 3. Participation in a Connect Group
 4. Satisfactory completion of felony statement/background check

Primary Responsibilities

- Reports directly to the Central Worship Pastor
- Plan, oversee and evaluate all components of the Connection Student Worship Ministry.
- Establish goals and objectives for this ministry and initiate strategies to fulfill them.
- Work closely with the Central Worship Pastor to ensure continuity of worship service programming among campuses.
- Supervise the enlistment, education and evaluation of all leaders in the Connection Student Worship Ministry, which may include worship vocalists, band members, and production.
- Train worship leaders in keeping with the principles taught in Ephesians 4:11-12.
- Regularly communicate with the Connection Student Pastor, peers, subordinates and leaders concerning the strategies and activities of worship services and schedule activities in accordance with Connection Church's policy and procedures.
- Plan and manage all worship services through planning center online. Be diligent to plan ahead for multiple weeks at a time.
- Conduct regular discipleship meetings with leaders.
- Assist Central Worship Pastor as necessary in the successful completion of Sunday morning services, worship events, and special events.
- Participate in the selection of worship resources to effectively communicate God's eternal truths while remaining up-to-date on new resources.
