

I was all over the place, I was crying, I was shaking and I looked over and Andrew is fine. I said how are you ok???? Did you hear what he said??? He looked at me and said God immediately in that moment gave him peace that he was going to be okay. Andrews faith stayed constant and strong but I just kept asking God, where are you? If you love me, why are you allowing this? Where are you? And as I sat and prayed night after night, I realized He had always been with us.

He was there when we were anointed with oil and the pastor, staff, and elders prayed over us. He was there every time someone from church calls, texts, or visits us to say they are praying for us. He was there when meal trains were set up for us. He was there every time someone stops what they are doing to care for us, listen to us, and encourage us. He was there when Mr. Gary told me he would cut off all his beautiful hair in support of Andrew having to do chemo.

I could name so many more instances but God is here. We would not be able to go through this journey without Connection Church and its community. We are not just another number. God's love is so evident and it is exemplified by the people here. We could not get through this without God and the love Connection Church has shown us. The people here fight with us and for us every step of the way. This church has changed our lives forever and we are honored to be a part of it.
