- Selection, editing and implementation of curriculum for Sundays for children in 1-5th grades including putting together all materials needed for small groups.
- Recruit new leaders and connectors for children in 1st through 5th grades including adults, college students, and teens.
- Equip 1st through 5th grade leaders with resources and skills you are learning. Continue to equip them in their ability to lead both large and small groups.
- Equipping 1st through 5th grade leaders with Sunday lessons, crafts and activities
- Work to create safe and fun opportunities and environments in which 1st 5th graders have opportunities to increase their knowledge of God and grow a deeper, personal relationship with Jesus.
- Work with Children's Director to select and implement a Vacation Bible School curriculum for the summer. Coordinate all logistics for VBS.
- Build positive relationships with families and equip parents to lead their children spiritually at home.
- Follow-up with children and families on a regular basis via email, phone calls, in person, and even school lunch visits
