They are focusing on what they want, rather than the well being of the relationship or other person. Don't expect your partner to be strong enough to avoid temptation for both of you. Have an honest conversation about realistic boundaries that you can set to keep your relationship pure. We believe that purity now will lead to true intimacy in marriage.
