## **Backpack Buddies**

This community driven effort supplies at-risk school children with selfserve food items. By working with school counselors, they identify and provide these children during the school year and during the summer with take-home bags of food when free and reduced programs are not available or adequate for complete nutrition.

Through relationships with school counselors and other staff, each year we have the opportunity to provide various school supplies, clothing and other needs students might have. We often hear counselors say, "I didn't know who else to call," and we hope to answer that call every time it comes in!
