Reenact this week's story of Palm Sunday. Grab some coats and blankets and lay them on the floor. Wave some papers like palm branches. Shout, "Hosanna!" "Hosanna!" Talk through the story of Jesus coming to Jerusalem (John 12:12-16). (Once you are done, put back all your props!)

KNOW that Jesus coming to Jerusalem was part of God's bigger story.

Read Philippians 1:6. What do you think it means that God will begin and complete a good work in you? Talk with your adult about ways you've seen God do good things in you and those around you.
