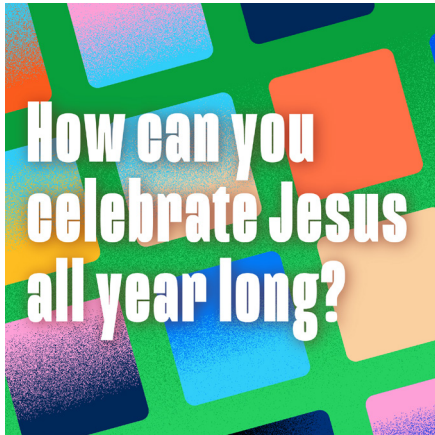


Spend some time thinking about the question below and journal your thoughts or share them with a parent.

## Day 4

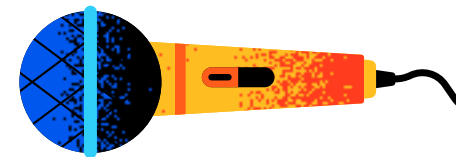
