DAY
1

Trust in the Lord with all your heart

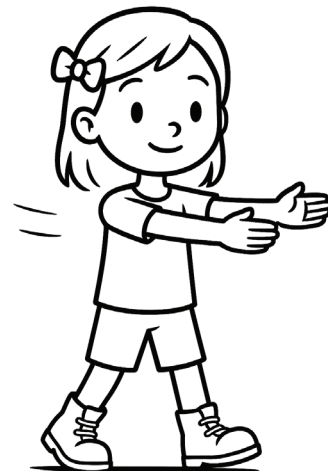
