Primary Responsibilities for Student Ministry

- Plan, lead, and organize all aspects of student ministry
- Lead, train and equip all volunteers serving in student ministry while also raising up more
- Meet with and disciple students one on one. Train leaders to do the same
- Plan and organize all events associated with student ministry
- Monitor budget for all purchases related to student ministry
- Become actively involved in students' lives by attending games, extracurricular activities, and miscellaneous events
- Cast vision and creatively develop all Wednesday night services alongside current student ministry staff
- Seek to establish relationships with all Bulloch County schools, not just where we have good connections already
- Mobilize students to serve the local church and the community
- Keep ongoing communication with parents for all actively involved students
- Partner with parents to establish discipleship in the home
- Create opportunities for students to gather outside of Wednesdays
- Commit to prayer, time in the word, and research to best be able to communicate God's word
- Work with pastoral staff to foster a student ministry that is aligned with the same vision of the church as the whole
